As you see India's top leaders like Mahatma Gandhi, Narendra Modi, Indira Gandhi, Also Americas Barak Obama, Englands Winston Churchill, Religious leaders like Dalai Lama, Pope and film stars like Amitabh Bachan, Aiswarya Rai, Deepika Padukone, Madhuri Dixit, Sharukh Khan, Salman Khan, Rithik Roshan, Marilyn Monroe, Charlie Chaplin, Steven Spielberg, Silvester stallion...etc and sports men like Sachin Tendulkar, Pele, Steffi Graff and many more. It's a splendid opportunity to take pictures & videos with them as in real. Show your friends, they can never unbelieve it. Return to hotel. Check in and a good rest at leisure

Evening some time Free for shopping for your favorite items of London. Indian dinner at the Indian restaurant. Overnight hotel for good rest and relaxation.

DAY 3 LONDON, ENGLAND, UK

After delicious buffet breakfast checkout and transfer to city to meet your local english speaking guide for a much awaited **city tour of London** as the guide explains all the highlights of London's landmarks you can marvel the sights and have pictures of Natural history museum, Big Ben, (clock tower) St. Pauls Cathedral, Houses of Parliament, Oxford Street, Piccadilly Circus, West Minister Abbey, Tower Bridge, and many other bridges across the Thames river and London city, Shard Tower the new landmark of London city, Downing Street, London Bridge, London Eye, London tower, Thames river & the floating cruises, National Gallery, Harrods, Baker street, Oxford street, etc.

Later walking through St James's Park, you will reach in Buckingham Palace. Here you will see the changing of the guards, (subject to availability as this is decided by many factors like climate, and other official circumstances) a colorful spectacle and British pageantry since 1660. Changing the Guard takes place outside Buckingham Palace. The New Guard arrives from Wellington Barracks and takes over the responsibilities of the Old Guard in a formal ceremony accompanied by music. The guard that looks after Buckingham Palace is called The Queen's Guard and is made up of soldiers on active duty from the Household Division's Foot Guards. The guards are dressed in traditional red tunics and bearskin hats. This is a very popular and colorful function in London and thousands from all over the world throng in the vicinity bearing cold weather and rain often.

Later you will get chance to walking tour of **Tower of Bridge**. Tower Bridge, one of London's most famous landmarks, was opened in 1894 by The Prince of Wales, later King Edward VII. Designed by Sir Horace Jones is the major tourist attraction and offering unique views of London from the bridge. Tower Bridge is a two sided suspension bridge combined with a spectacular Draw bridge (bascule). The two 65m steel framed towers, decorated in Cornish granite and Portland stone, are built on huge concrete piers sunk into River Thames.

A sumptuous lunch at the Indian restaurant. After the lunch we proceed to have a **Memorable experience in London Eye** (optional). The London Eye is a giant wheel on the Bank of the river Thames with 443 ft. tall and the wheel has a diameter of 394 ft. You will get a bird eye view of London city and it takes you on a 30 minute flight, rising to 450 feet above the river Thames very slowly, viewing London's most famous streets, churches, Palaces and monuments are spread out before you on the clear sky. It has 32 cubicles and each flight can take 30 passengers in it easily.

Day 4 Hague, AMSTERDAM, NETHERLANDS



After a good night sleep in the luxurious ship, Enjoy a good continental breakfast and check out of the cruise, you have arrived in Hague, with your long distance coach for the rest of the journey of Europe you begin your Tour of Europe with Amsterdam.

We visit - **Keukenhof**, also known as the **Garden of Europe**, is one of the world's largest flower Botanical garden, situated in Lisse, Netherlands. Keukenhof Tulip Gardens is opening on 21 March 2024 and will be open until 12 May 2024. (After 12 May, we will be showing you **Madurodam** – miniature of Holland instead of Tulip gardens) According to the official website, Keukenhof Park covers an area of 32 hectares and approximately 7 million flower bulbs are planted in the gardens annually. Opened in 1950 More than 15,00,000 (in 2019) visitors, If you want to see the larger tulips blooming in their full glory, you should visit between mid-April and mid-May. On average, you will need 2 hours to visit Keukenhof Gardens. During this time second period the hyacinths start flowering. The flower fields color purple, pink, white and blue in beautiful pastel shades. The hyacinths also bloom in Keukenhof together with more and more early tulips.

Amsterdam is Netherlands' capital, known for its elaborate canal system and narrow houses with gabled facades, legacies of the city's 17th-century Golden Age. Amsterdam also famous for night life known as red light area. The Rembrandtplein and the adjoining Thorbeckeplein are the most popular nightlife areas of Amsterdam. The rectangular square is surrounded by trendy clubs Studio 80 and Escape, many lovely cafés, coffee shops, good restaurants, and sunny terraces. Sit back, relax in your coach, and will have a guided city tour of Amsterdam and proceed to Dam Square. Here you'll find the Royal Palace, National Monument, the new church, Ann Frank Museum which welcomes visitors.

It was created in the 13th century when a dam was built around the river Amstel to prevent the Zuiderzeesea from flooding the city. During the sixties, the square was renowned for its Dam Square hippies. These days it is one of the main tourist sights and expect lots of entertainment. You also watch the boat cruises in the canals. During the city tour, you will be passing all of the city's highlights, from the famous 17th century canal houses to the modern, urban areas at the IJ. Spot the Westerkerk, the Skinny Bridge and way more! Time permitting you can also have **The ZaanseSchans village Tour** Clogs, tulips, cheese and windmills are the quintessential symbols of the Netherlands, just one hour from Amsterdam. The heavenly smells of chocolate and fresh-baked waffles waft over you as you pass through the entrance to the ZaanseSchans windmill village, which is like a living museum. Later transfer to Hotel.

Day 5 Amsterdam BRUSSELS, Belgium – PARIS, FRANCE

After continental breakfast proceed by your long distance coach to Brussels, capital of Belgium, here we go on a **walking tour of Brussels** to visit the Grand Palace & the **Mannequin piz statue** along the line of various chocolates shops. Brussels is considered the capital of the European Union having a long history of hosting the institutions of the European Union within its European Quarter. Continue your journey to view the Atomium, the landmark of Brussels. The Atomium is a building in Brussels originally constructed for Expo 1958, Brussels World's Fair. Designed by the engineer André Waterkeyn and architects André and Jean Polak, it stands 102 m (335 ft) tall. Its nine 18 m (59 ft) diameter stainless steel clad spheres are connected so that the whole forms the shape of a unit cell of an iron crystal magnified 165 billion times. Continue our journey to Paris.

Lunch, Dinner from Indian restaurants. Overnight hotel stay in Paris.

Day 6 PARIS, France



Morning after a Buffet breakfast in your hotel proceed by our coach on a Paris Guided city Tour. Paris is the capital and most-populous city of France. The city of fashion, theatre and arts and is supposed to bethe most beautiful city in the World. Visit Notre-Dame Cathedral, Champs-Élysées, Concorde, Arc of Triomphe, Invalides, Musée d'Orsay, Opera House, Magdalene Church, Vondem Square, Alexander Bridge, Concorde Square, Louvre Museum (photo stop), Palais Garnier, Opéra National de Paris Siene River & innumerable boats and much more. Visit Eiffel Tower After lunch we visit Eiffel Tower-2nd/3rd level (subject to operation). The Eiffel Tower is a wrought-iron lattice tower on the Champ de Mars in Paris, named after the engineer Gustave Eiffel, whose company designed and built the tower. Towering more than 1,000 feet (300 meters) this iron structure was constructed for the 1889 World Expo by Gustave Eiffel. One of the world's most photographed tourist attractions, the Eiffel Tower presents an excellent photography opportunity for both day and night times. Visitors can ride the elevator to see incredible views of the city. You can have an optional tour of Paris by night including the Eiffel tower at night as well as a Scene River cruise.

Day 7 PARIS – TITISEE, BLACK FOREST, DRUBBA, CUCKOO CLOCK, GERMANY

After continental breakfast, check out from the hotel and proceed to the beautiful city Titisee, Neustadt, in the Southern Black Forest Nature Park, Germany, and the heart of it is the Lake Titisee with hundreds of pink flamingoes. Long-distance trails pass Titisee Lake's Seestrasse promenade and climb Hochfirst Mountain, which has views from Hochfirst Tower. Hochfirstschanze hill is a natural ski jump. Rodelbahn Saig-Titisee has sled runs in winter, when ski slopes are open. Titisee is very famous for its serene lovely climate, flowers on both sides of the Road lined as a garden by itself and shops selling varieties of wines at a nominal price, leather items, belts, clothes, dresses, woolen items, and other accessories, including many different types of **Cuckoo clocks**.

It is the origin of Cuckoo clock, known as **DRUBBA** where you can have a demonstration of how Cuckoo clock is being made and you can buy the original cuckoo clock one of your choice to decorate your houses and office. You have the magnificent views of the **Black Forest** with breathtaking landscape and the fine architecture of the Middle Ages.

In the Alemannic dialect Teti means "little child" or "baby". Titisee would then be a lake from which, according to local legend, small children came, similar to the story told in other places that babies are delivered by a white stork. Long known as a spa town, Legend says the name came from Roman Emperor Titus, who was so taken by its beauty that he named it after himself. (We will be doing this tour either this evening or next day morning subject to time of arrival in the evening).

Indian Lunch and dinner from the restaurant. Overnight hotel in Titisee/Frieburg for rest and relaxation.

Day 8 Germany, Schafhaussen Rhine Falls, Zurich, Switzerland.

After a lovely breakfast from our hotel, we pack up and proceed to Switzerland, the dream destination of every traveler. Enroute we visit the most enchanting water falls - The Schafhaussen Rhine Falls is a waterfall located in Switzerland and the most powerful waterfall in Europe, located on the High Rhine on the border between the cantons of Schaffhausen and Zürich known as Niagara Falls of Europe.

On arrival we will transfer to hotel. With your tour leader enjoy a **panoramic tour of Zurich**. Dinner and overnight stay at hotel in Switzerland

Day 9 SWITZERLAND Mt.Titlis, Engelburg, Lucerne city

Mount Titlis is Central Switzerland's loftiest peak attracting ski lovers from across the world. On unforgettable ride in cable car to the top of Swiss Alps in at 3020 m /10000 ft. You will switch two different cable cars, and be amazed as the scenery changes from green meadows and scenic lakes to snow clad mountains. The last leg of the ride is one of the famous Rotair, which is the world's first revolving cable car, on which you will get an incredibly panoramic view of the surrounding glaciers, mountains and scenery. A visual treat for people across the world. Breathe in the fresh air and enjoy the stunning views offered by this snow-clad mountain at 10,000 feet. You will get a chance to enjoy lunch on top of the mountain at 6000 ft hight at Trubse. This location has been specially chosen for you to get a real feel of Switzerland.

Visit the beautiful Luzern Lake After lunch you will transfer to Luzern, the beautiful city in Switzerland. Luzern, a compact city in central Switzerland, sits amid snowcapped mountains on the north end of Lake Luzern. With its colorful old town and the iconic Kapellbrücke and spired, turreted buildings, it's the story book image of a Swiss town. Orientation tour of Luzern with your tour leader visit Luzern city, Luzern Lake, Keppel Bridge, Lion monument a typical Swiss house & various shops for Swiss chocolates, knives, souvenirs'.

Day 10 SWITZERLAND - St Gotthard Pass, COMO-PADOVA

After a sumptuous breakfast in the hotel in Switzerland, check out and proceed to Italy, through **Gotthard Road Tunnel**, which is 16.9 kilometres (10.5 mi) in length below the St Gotthard Pass, a major pass of the Alps mountain. During its construction, in 1980, it was the longest road tunnel in the world; currently the fourth-longest.

Lake Como, the most beautiful Italian Lake -We arrive at the Italian lake city of Como. Set among the southern foothills of the Alps, the Italian Lakes extend over four different regions of northwest Italy. The most famous trio are stately Maggiore, where snowcapped peaks form a dramatic backdrop to the enchanting Borromeo Islands; beguiling Como, where mountains plunge

into the deep waters and charming villages cling to the slopes; and vast, diverse Garda, similar to a fjord at its northern end and resembling a sea to the south. We enjoy an Italian lunch here.

After lunch we will proceed to Padua, time permitting, Experience the grandeur of the Basilica di Sant'Antonio di **Padova**, where St. Anthony was buried, an internationally revered pilgrimage site dating back to the 13th century. Byzantine-style., original name Fernando Martins de Bulhões, (born 1195, Lisbon, Portugal—died June 13, 1231, Arcella, Verona [Italy]; patron of the poor. Padua and Portugal claim him as their patron saint, and he is invoked for the return of lost property. Anthony was the most celebrated of St. Francis of Assisi's followers and had the reputation of a miracle worker. In art he is shown with a book, a heart, a flame, a lily, or the child Jesus. Italian Lunch and Indian dinner. Overnight hotel in Padova.

Day 11 Padova, VENICE, PISA ITALY

Morning after the breakfast, we continue our journey into **Venice**, the capital of northern Italy's Veneto region, Italy. Regarded as one of the world's most picturesque cities, Venice attracts millions of visitors every year who travel from all corners of the globe to experience its unique charms. Its built across a group of 118 small islands and is renowned for its history, architecture, and contributions to the arts and culture. It has no roads, just canals – including the Grand Canal thoroughfare lined with Renaissance and Gothic palace. Venice is a major seaport and it was the greatest seaport in late medieval Europe and the continent's commercial and cultural link to Asia.

Visit the romantic Venice Island On arrival in Mestre, you board to a private boat which will take you to the heart of the traditional city on the bank of Adriatic Sea. Venice's waterways host a wealth of impressive structures, popular visitor attractions like Piazza San Marco, Basilica di San Marco. The basilica includes a Bell Tower, which stands more than 98 meters tall and is one of the city's most recognizable landmarks. The other major attraction in St. Mark's Square is Doge's Palace. The former seat of the Venetian government, this ornate palace is one of the most enduring symbols of Venice, and a masterpiece of Gothic architecture. The whole city is an extraordinary architectural masterpiece in which even the smallest building contains works by some of the world's greatest artists. Explore Venice city in Gondola ride (Optional). After the tour of Venice we return to the main land by the fast moving boat, and go for an Indian lunch.

Visit Leaning Tower of Pisa -transfer to Pisa, a city in Italy's Tuscany region best known for its iconic Leaning Tower. On arrival we visit the Leaning Tower of Pisa (outside view only). The Leaning Tower of Pisa is a freestanding bell tower,

of the cathedral of the Italian city of Pisa, known worldwide for its nearly four-degree lean. The tower is situated behind the Pisa Cathedral and is the third-oldest structure in the city's Cathedral Square, after the cathedral and the Pisa Baptistry. The place is also known for its miraculous work, hence call it as **Miraculi church** and is very famous. Later transfer to hotel.

Indian lunch and dinner and overnight stay at hotel in Pisa.

Day 12 PISA – ROME, ITALY, VATICAN CITY & MUSEUM



Visit the Eternal City . Morning after the breakfast, checkout , and we continue our journey into the eternal city Rome and upon arrival we visit Vatican City and the with Sistine chapel And St. Peters Basilica. Vatican is the smallest country in the world or as one says a country within a country with an area of approximately 44 hectares (110 acres), and a population of 1,000, it is the smallest state in the world by both area and population. Vatican City is an independent state, the temporal seat of the Pope, head of the worldwide Catholic Church; entirely surrounded by the city of Rome, in Italy. Take pictures from Vatican Square. Collect books and periodicals or souvenirs from the nearest shops available.

Indian Lunch and dinner. Overnight stay hotel in Rome

Day 13 ROME, Sightseeing

After the breakfast we proceed for the guided **city tour of Rome** with an English-speaking local guide, who will show you loved sights like St. Peter's Basilica, Colosseum, Circus Maximus, Piazza Venezia, Tiber River, Roman Forum, Trevi Fountain, Fort Angelo, the Monument of Victor Emmanuel II, Arch de Constantine, the Arch of Augustus & other

important Roman monuments. Colosseum is also known as the Flavian Amphitheatre is an elliptical amphitheater in the center of the city of Rome, Italy built with concrete and stone in seventh century. The Colosseum could hold 50,000 to 80,000 spectators and was used for gladiatorial contests and public spectacles such as mock sea battles, animal hunts, executions, re-enactments of famous battles, and dramas based on Classical mythology.
