## Day 1

### Departure

Departure for Cairns, New Zealand by the evening flight, the north of Australia, the most popular tourist attraction – home to one of the SEVEN Natural Wonders of the world – All meals in flight.

## Day 2

### CAIRNS, Australia

Arrival Cairns International Airport in the evening. After emigration, collection of your luggage, customs, buy your personal items at the duty free shops, then transfer to hotel in Cairns .

Evening Indian dinner from the restaurant. Overnight hotel Pacific Hotel Cairns or similar

## Day 3

### CAIRNS, TOUR TO THE OUTER GREAT BARRIER REEF

Visit Great Barrier Reef, one of the seven natural wonders of the world – is the largest coral reef system in the world composed of over 2,900 individual reefs and 900 islands stretching over an area of approximately 3,44,400 square kilometers in Northern Australia, off the coast of Queensland . It can be seen from outer space and is the world's biggest single structure made by living organisms, built by billions of tiny organisms, known as coral polyps and was selected as a World Heritage Site in 1981.

In the full day cruise operates a fast, air-conditioned catamaran to a large pontoon (floating platform) located at pristine Moore Reef on the outer edge of the Great Barrier Reef, approximately 40km from Cairns. Its equipped with complete snorkel equipment, glass bottom boat, semi-submersible coral reef viewing boat, an underwater observatory, marine life touch tank, ( optional scuba diving, guided snorkeling safari, Sea walker and Helmet.) Guided coral viewing from glass bottomed boat and semi-submersible, fish feeding presentation, a sumptuous hot and cold buffet lunch featuring seafood. Return to the shore in the evening. Transfer to hotel, Dinner and overnight stay at hotel in Cairns.

Breakfast at the hotel. International Buffet Lunch in the cruise. Indian dinner at the restaurant. Overnight hotel.

## Day 4

### Cairns, fly to SYDNEY , OPERA HOUSE

Today morning check out of the hotel , transfer to airport for your onward flight to Sydney, the most vibrant city of Australia . On arrival at Sydney, collect your luggage and transfer to hotel.

Visit Sydney Opera House, one of the undisputable masterpieces of human creativity. Take photos and videos of the marvelous piece on the steps of the Opera House, explore its majestic exterior and splendid interior and enjoy performances held under its iconic white sails. The Sydney Opera House is a multi-venue performing arts centre at Sydney Harbour near the harbour bridge and hosts 1,600 performances every year including ballet, opera, theatre, dance, music. Designed by Danish architect Jorn Utzon , the building was formally opened on 20 October 1973. On 28 June 2007 the Sydney Opera House was included on the UNESCO World Heritage List, placing it alongside the Taj Mahal, the ancient Pyramids of Egypt and the Great Wall of China as one of the most outstanding places on Earth and it is the youngest cultural site to ever be included on the World Heritage List.

Now it is one of the most popular visitor attractions in Australia, the site is visited by more than eight million people annually.

Transfer to hotel. Holiday Inn Darling Harbour Sydney or similar

Breakfast at the hotel. Light lunch in flight. Indian dinner at the restaurant.





## Day 5

### **SYDNEY, Sightseeing, Bondi Beach, Harbour Cruise, Harbour Sky Bridge, Shopping**

Morning proceed on a city sightseeing tour of Sydney .

In a guided city tour See Sydney, capital of New South Wales is best known for its beautiful and magnificent harbour front , Sydney Opera House, with a distinctive sail-like design. Massive Darling harbour and the smaller Circular Quay port are hubs of waterside life, with the arched harbour Bridge and esteemed Royal Botanical Garden nearby. Visit Mrs. Macquarie's Chair, Sydney harbour, The Rock, King Cross, Sydney Tower - the tallest structure and the second tallest observation tower in the Southern Hemisphere. The tower stands 309 m (1,014 ft) above the Sydney central business district (CBD) and is one of the most prominent tourist attractions in the city, Designed by Australian architect Donald Crone, other important attractions. Later time free for shopping in Sydney.

Evening visit the famous Bondi beach with a bustling social scene and top-notch restaurants and cafés. Bondi is one of Sydney's most iconic beach suburbs - and for good reason Even to locals, the golden sands of Bondi Beach are a slice of heaven, and its proximity to the city makes it easily accessible. Each day the sunrise brings early-morning surfers, swims in ocean pools. As the sun sets, beachside bars come to life and shoppers browse designer boutiques. From morning to night Bondi has it all. (Alcohol is banned on the beach )

Breakfast at the hotel. Lunch and Dinner from the Indian restaurant .Overnight stay at hotel.

## Day 6

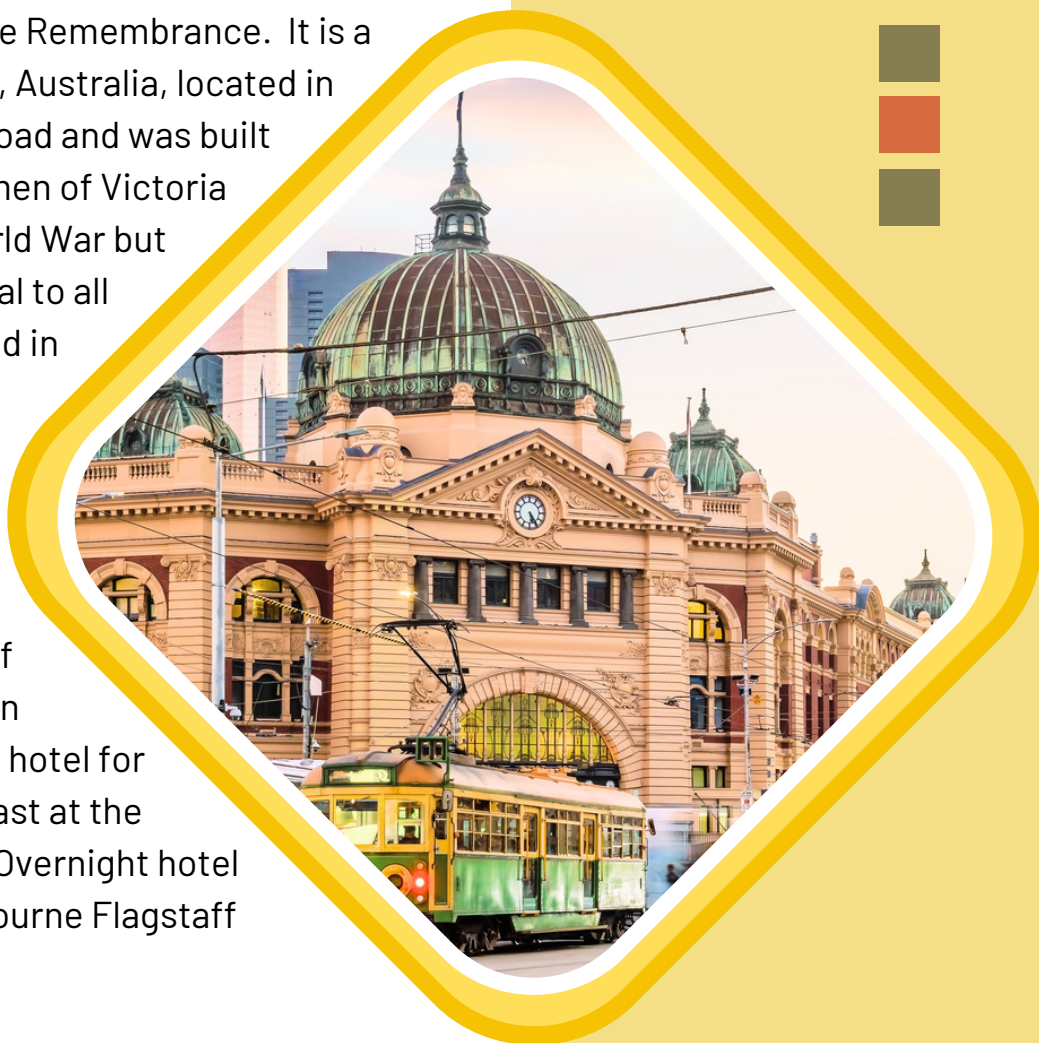
### **Sydney, fly to MELBOURNE , Sightseeing,**

Morning transfer to Sydney airport, for your onward flight to Melbourne .Upon arrival collect luggage and transfer to hotel.

Afternoon guided Melbourne city tour. Visit the Town Hall, Old Parliament House, St. Patrick's Cathedral, Royal Exhibition Building, Federation Square, Arts Center, Outside view of the Shrine of Remembrance, town hall.....etc. Later visit Fitzroy Garden and here visit Captain Cook's, the famous navigator's cottage from outside. The cottage was constructed in 1755 in the English village of Great Ayton, by the parents of Captain James Cook and was brought to Melbourne in 1934 by Sir Russell Grimwade.

Later visit The Shrine of the Remembrance. It is a war memorial in Melbourne, Australia, located in Kings Domain on St Kilda Road and was built to honour the men and women of Victoria who served in the First World War but now functions as a memorial to all Australians who have served in any war.

It is a site of annual observances for ANZAC Day (25 April) and Remembrance Day (11 November), and is one of the largest war memorials in Australia. Later transfer to hotel for rest and relaxation. Breakfast at the hotel. Light lunch in flight. Overnight hotel Courtyard by Marriott Melbourne Flagstaff Gardens or similar.



## Day 7

### **MELBOURNE – Sightseeing , Kangaroos Viewing Park & Shopping**

Morning Continue the sightseeing with a visit to the Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG). MCG popularly known as 'The G', is the largest Cricket Stadium with a capacity of 100,024 spectators in the world and the 10th-largest stadium in its size and has the tallest light towers of any sporting venue interestingly, cricket's first ODI match was also held at the MCG.

Afternoon we visit Ballarat Wildlife park or Moonlit Sanctuary Wildlife Conservation Park to see the Kangaroos and other animals in the Park,

Time permitting you can also visit the Melbourne Aquarium to see the fantastic view of the Sea Life. Evening time free for shopping in Melbourne. Later transfer to hotel for overnight.

Breakfast at the hotel, Indian Lunch & Dinner at the restaurant. Overnight hotel.



## Day 8

### **Melbourne – fly to CHRISTCHURCH, New Zealand sightseeing**

Morning transfer to airport for your onward journey to New Zealand , transfer to Melbourne International airport for your flight to Christchurch. Upon arrival clear your emigration, luggage collection, customs, then transfer to hotel.

New Zealand is an island country in the southwestern Pacific Ocean. It consists of two main landmasses the North Island and the South Island and over 700 smaller islands.

Christchurch sightseeing – the Garden city – Botanical Gardens, located in the central city of Christchurch, visit the natural beauty of Hagley Park, the Avon River , The Canterbury Museum & University – where you see a surprising features including Maori and Antarctic discovery collections, Human & Natural history of regions. Continue visit Mona Vale, formerly known as Karewa, most spectacular gardens & public park of Fendalton. The Bridge of Remembrance is one of two main war memorials, the Cardboard Cathedral – the transitional pro-cathedral of the Anglican Diocese of Christchurch designed by architect Shigeru Ban and seats around 700 people & Cathedral Square. Transfer to hotel. Rest and relaxation.

Breakfast at the hotel. Light lunch in flight. Indian dinner at the restaurant. Overnight hotel The Premier Inn Christchurch West hotel or similar.

## Day 9

### **Christchurch, GREYMOUTH – TranzAlpine Express Train , FRANZ JOSEF GLACIER REGION, Sightseeing**

Morning Transfer to Christchurch Railway Station. Here we take the TranzAlpine Express Train journey into Greymouth for Glacier Region and Franz Josef.

Enjoy the beautiful scenic journey by train. On arrival, continue by coach journey into Franz Josef & Glacier Region – enroute views of Kumara Junction & Taramakau Rail bridge , Hokitika town . Hokitika Gorge, West Coast, Treetop Walk Ross, Lake Lanthe, Pakihi Walk, Okarito Lake Mapourika Recreational Area etc as much as you get time to watch them enroute.

Upon Glacier Region. Upon arrival transfer to hotel for rest and relaxation .

Evening enjoy the Glacier Hot Pools which offers the ultimate hot springs experience in New Zealand's West Coast – is totally unique, romantic, oasis in the rainforest. It weaves their way through the rainforest and is a superb place to relax and rejuvenate amongst nature (duration: unlimited). Immerse yourself in a choice of 3 invitingly warm public pools under nature's leafy canopy. ( Main Pool admission provided. Spa & Massage extra )

Breakfast at the hotel. Lunch locally. Dinner at the restaurant in the hotel locally. Hotel Alpine Glacier Motor Lodge or similar.

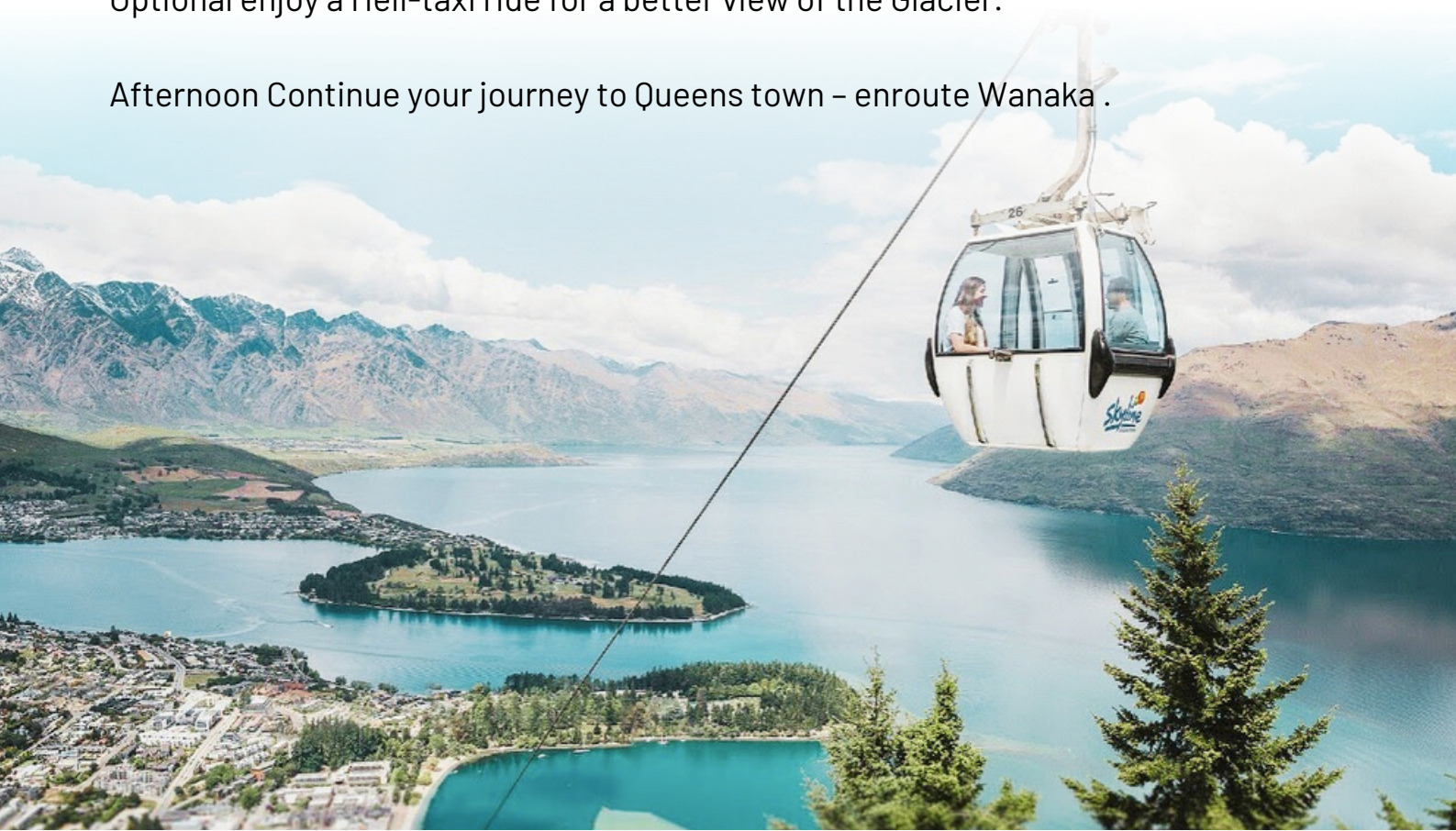
## Day 10

### **GLACIER REGION- FRANZ JOSEF > WANAKA > QUEENS TOWN SKYLINE GONDOLA RIDE**

Morning we Visit the Franz Josef Glacier Public Viewing Point (Driver will drop group at the public car park, passengers have then chance to take a walk to view the glacier from a safe distance monitored by the Department of Conservation). The most dramatic formations occur on a glacier when it moves downwards on a steep gradient and at Franz Josef is steep. The surface of Franz Josef Glacier is full of crevasses and ice caves, where you have a much better chance of seeing the famous blue ice.

Optional enjoy a Heli-taxi ride for a better view of the Glacier.

Afternoon Continue your journey to Queens town – enroute Wanaka .







## **Wanaka -**

With its snow-capped mountains, vast lakes and rolling farmlands, is a dream destination for many, a charming tourist destination located on the southern tip of Lake Wanaka . It's the ultimate alpine playground with an array of adventure activities to take part in, as well as ways to relax. the drive provides a stunning scenic connection between these two southern gems! The road is windy and it passes lots of lakes, rivers, waterfalls, and viewpoints making it one of the best drives in New Zealand.

## **Queens Town -**

Rich in history, an abundance of recreations and a breath taking natural beauty. One of the most beautiful towns in the world . The area is used as the locations for many Hollywood and Bollywood films. Upon arrival , Visit Arrow town, experience the bungee jumping, or watch bungee jumping off Kawarau Gorge Suspension Bridge and jet-boating on the Shot over and Dart rivers, skiing on the slopes of The Remarkable and Coronet Peak Lake Wakatipu, one of the most beautiful sights in the world. A real paradise on earth. Before night, take a fabulous Gondola Ride the Gondola high above Queenstown to discover a view you'll never forget - Gliding above the town centre, one of the world's clearest skies.

## **Skyline Gondola ride -**

with Stratosphere Buffet at top of Bob's Peak, the global thrill ride for all ages, Situated an easy five-minute walk from central Queenstown, the Gondola carries visitors high above Queenstown to the Skyline complex. Jump in your specialised Luge cart and take on over 800m of banked corners, tunnels & dippers, The best views in the region are found here, spread out in a spectacular panorama with breathtaking views of Coronet Peak, The Remarkables mountain range and across Lake Wakatipu to Cecil and Walter Peak.

Breakfast at the hotel. Local lunch enroute. Indian dinner at the restaurant.  
Transfer to hotel Holiday Inn Queenstown or similar.

## Day 11

### **QUEENS TOWN >MILFORD SOUND CRUISE – MITRE PEAK – LAKE WAKATIPU -TE ANAU- HOMER TUNNEL**

Depart early morning hours for a Full day excursion to Milford Sound cruise a never miss attraction of New Zealand – Milford Sound is the Eighth Wonder of the World in New Zealand. It has been judged as the world's top travel destination in an international survey and is acclaimed as New Zealand's most famous and favorite tourist destination. Milford Sound is a long narrow inlet located at the northernmost end of Fiordland National Park, opening out onto the Tasman Sea.

One of the first highlights of a trip to Milford Sound is the Eglinton Valley. Several areas in the Eglinton Valley were locations in 'the Lord of the Rings' movies, in particular the Eglinton mountains which represented the Misty Mountains in the Fellowship of the Ring. Within the Eglinton Valley you'll also find the famous Mirror Lakes and Knobs Flat. One of the highlights of the Milford Road, the Mirror Lakes are world famous for their beauty and the way they reflect their surrounding scenery. You'll find the Mirror Lakes within the Eglinton Valley, a breath-taking reflection of the Earl Mountain ranges opposite. Knobs Flat was the site where the workers building the road to Milford Sound camped up until the 1980s. Then pass-through PopsView Lookout and Hollyford Valley Lookout, Falls Creek waterfalls, monkey creek, Tutoko River Bridge, The Chasm and Homer Tunnel.

Upon reaching Milford Sound, board a luxurious catamaran. Described by Rudyard Kipling as the 'eighth wonder of the world', Milford Sound was carved by glaciers during the ice ages. Departing from Milford Wharf, this boat cruise glides past snow-capped Mitre Peak and waterfalls cascading down steep-walled mountains that rise straight up from the water. See Bowen Falls, Stirling Falls and Seal Point while searching the deep fiord for marine life including bottlenose dolphins and New Zealand fur seals. With a delicious Picnic Lunch and visit to the Milford Discovery Centre included,

Breakfast at the hotel, International Lunch on board the cruise, Indian dinner at the restaurant on return . Overnight hotel in Queenstown.





## Day 12

### **Queens Town – AUCKLAND – ROTORUA Sighting AUCKLAND**

Morning checkout of your hotel and transfer to Queens town Airport for your onward journey into the Northern Island of New Zealand, and the main city - Haere Mai" Welcome to Auckland, the City of Sails.

Rotorua - Upon arrival at Auckland Airport collect your luggage, and continue by your coach journey through Hamilton and arrive at Rotorua, the geothermal wonderland in New Zealand. Rotorua is a city on the southern shores of Lake Rotorua located in the Bay of Plenty Region of New Zealand's North Island. It is a major tourist destination in New Zealand known for its geothermal activity, and features geysers notably the Pohutu Geyser at Whakarewarewa - and hot mud pools. There is a scent of sulphur in the air. Upon arrival in Rotorua, we enjoy a panoramic city tour of Rotorua - The tour begins in the heart of Rotorua and see historic buildings, government gardens, Rotorua Museum (outside view) the blue paths and more. From there, head out to the picturesque Lake Tikitapu (Lake blue) for the first splashdown before you head to lake Okareka for your second splash down, nestled in the heart of a small vibrant community. It will be a life time experience in Rotorua .

Transfer to hotel Sudima Lake Resort or similar. Late evening enjoy a Polynesian Spa . Breakfast at the hotel. Indian Lunch and dinner at the restaurant. Overnight hotel.

## Day 13

### **ROTORUA-TE PUIA – Geo thermal hot springs Sighting – Polynesian Spa**

#### **Polynesian Spa**

Morning spend your time in the Polynesian Spa which gives your body and mind a rejuvenated energy and experience - spend some time at the hot spring . Later continue with the sightseeing of Rotorua.

Visit Te Puia, the geo thermal wonder in New Zealand.

Later we transfer to Te Puia, to see the bubbling mud pools and hot springs in Rotorua. Situated five minutes from central Rotorua, Te Puia is an iconic destination for visitors around the world featuring the world famous thermal volcanic pools. Home to Rotorua's Pohutu Geyser, Te Puia has plenty of geothermal marvels to explore, just on the outskirts of the town center.

Pohutu Geyser is the southern hemisphere's largest geyser and sprays water up to 30 meters in the air in eruptions. As well as all the geyser action, there are steaming alkaline springs, which the Maori use for cooking. When the geothermal sightseeing has finished, you are able to see Maori Arts and Crafts Institute where you can watch masters and students working on traditional wood and bone carvings and learn about the preservation of Maori artistry.

Traditional 'Hangi' dinner with Maori cultural show.

Later we immersed in Maori culture with a traditional 'Hangi' dinner and live performance (subject to availability). For dinner, feast on a multilayered meal cooked using the ancient Hangi pit oven method. Free time to enjoy delicious Maori Hangi dinner and concert.

Return to hotel and optional & time permitting visit Red Woods Tree walkin Nightlights.

Red woods Night lights is one of New Zealand's top design led tourism experiences that features 34 exquisite lanterns designed by world renowned designer and champion David Trubridge. Floating between 9-20 meters above the forest floor, this award-winning eco-tourism walk is 700 meters long walkway made up of 28 suspension bridges and platforms high amongst giant redwood trees. Enjoy extraordinary majestic beauty by day or the mesmerizing and magical forest illuminated with lanterns at night.

Breakfast at the hotel. Indian lunch and Local dinner . Overnight hotel in Rotorua.

## Day 14

### **ROTORUA- WAITOMO GLOW WORM CAVES tour AUCKLAND - Sightseeing**

#### **WAITOMO GLOW WORM CAVES TOUR**

Discover the nature's light display in the Waitomo Glowworm Caves tour.

Morning check out of the hotel and travel over the forested Mamaku Ranges to reach Waitomo. It's known for its extensive underground cave systems. Thousands of glowworms light up the Glowworm Caves., one of New Zealand's most popular sights. This deep limestone cave system, littered with huge stalactites, is home to hundreds of thousands of glowworms (*Arachnocampa Luminosa*) who illuminate the rock ceilings and walls in a spectacular display of twinkling, tiny spotlights.

Ancient world 30 million years in the making brought to life by the tour guide through story-telling its history, features and legends. Stunning, delicate cave formations and a boat ride through the starry wonderland .The Waitomo Glowworm Caves tours are made up of two levels. The upper being dry and decorated with stunning, delicate cave formations and the lower level consisting of stream passages, glowworms and the Cathedral, the tallest chamber in the cave. Many of the guides are direct descendants of the Maori chief who originally explored the cave, bringing the cave to life through story-telling and explaining the history, features and legends of the world-famous cave. Discover the Nature's light display as you glide silently through the starry wonderland of the Glowworm Grotto. Later you will travel through the lush farmland of the Waikato and reach in Auckland. Auckland was the second capital from 1841 until 1865, when Parliament was permanently moved to Wellington. Auckland is the largest city in New Zealand with about 1.4 million people. It is known as the "City of Sails" because there are many sailing boats in the city and is situated on two harbours: the Manukau and Waitemata harbours. The Hauraki Gulf has many different islands and provides safe anchorage and good sailing that is recognised around the world.

On arrival experience Auckland on an orientation tour of Auckland of its scenic highlights. Travel through the city centre and will reach at City Sky Tower. The Sky Tower is a telecommunications and observation tower in Auckland, New Zealand. Located at the corner of Victoria and Federal Streets, it is 328 metres tall, as measured from ground level to the top of the mast, making it the tallest freestanding structure in the Southern Hemisphere and the 25th tallest tower in the world. It has become an iconic landmark in Auckland's skyline due to its height and unique design and best place to get a bird eye view of Auckland city, the city of sails. ( Subject to open and entry )

Evening some time free for shopping. And later transfer to hotel after dinner.

Lunch locally and Indian Dinner at the restaurant

Overnight hotel Holiday Inn Auckland city.
