

Visit Delhi – Agra – Fatehpur Sikri – Jaipur & Amritsar & Wagah Border

See All..the historical Delhi (old & new), Taj Mahal – One of the man-made 7 wonders of the World, the Pink city of India – Jaipur & the Golden Temple of Amritsar & the famous Wagah border of our nation

Arrive Delhi - Delhi Sightseeing

Flight departure from your hub city, onto Delhi, the capital of India.

Upon your arrival in Delhi, airport, collect luggage and meet our representative waiting at the airport, transfer to hotel. Hotel Check into hotel (standard time of checkin after 1400 hrs and checkout before 1200 hrs.)

Afternoon based on your flight arrival, explore Delhi, India's capital territory, is a massive metropolitan area in the country's north. In Old Delhi, a neighborhood dating to the 1600s, stands the imposing Mughal-era Red Fort, a symbol of India, and the sprawling Jama Masjid mosque, whose courtyard accommodates 25,000 people. Nearby is Chandni Chowk, a vibrant bazaar filled with food carts, sweets shops and spice stalls.

Dinner. Overnight Stay at hotel in Delhi.

Day 02:

Delhi Sightseeing

City Tour of Delhi - Proceed on a Full day sight seeing of Old & New Delhi loaded with historic monuments and alluring sophisticated constructions. Visit - Jama Masjid - Red fort (out side only) - India Gate - President house (photo stop) - Parliament street (drive Through) - Bangla Sahib (Sikh Temple) - 30th January "Gandhi's Home" (Closed on Every Monday) - Rashtrapathi Bhavan, Delhi Metro, Akshardham temple for its unique structure and architect which is now world famous. (All the sightseeing in Delhi is possible only if the time punctuality is kept and also subject to traffic.)

Day 03

Delhi Sightseeing & onto Agra - Taj Mahal

Today continue with your Delhi sightseeing, which you missed out the previous, Lotus Temple (Closed on Every Monday)-QutubMinar, Raj Ghat (Cremation place of Mahatma Gandhi) - etc..

Lotus Temple:

Since its inauguration to public worship in December 1986, the Bahá'í House of Worship in Delhi has, as of late 2002, attracted more than 50 million visitors, making it one of the most visited buildings in the world. Its numbers of visitors during those years surpassed those of the Eiffel Tower and the Taj Mahal. On Hindu celebrative days and holy days, it has drawn as many as 150,000 people in one day.

Qutub Minar: The Qutb Minar was commissioned by Qutb-ud-din Aibak, the first Sultan of Delhi, and was completed by his successor - Iltutmish. It is not known whether the tower was named after Qutb-ud-din Aibak or Qutbuddin Bhaktiyar Kaki, a famous Sufi saint who was living in Delhi contemporarily. According to the inscriptions on its surface it was repaired by Firoz Shah Tughlaq (AD 1351-89) and Sikandar Lodi (AD 1489-1517).

Raj ghat:

Raj Ghat is primarily a twelve by twelve feet square platform which is made up of black marble. This platform represents the place where Mahatma Gandhi's last rites were performed on the next day of his assassination, i.e. on 31st January 1948. Since then it has been a tradition for all the Indian and foreign dignitaries to offer their respect at the Ghat on all the important occasions. All guests are required to remove their footwear before entering Raj Ghat as a mark of respect.

Afternoon continue your journey to Agra, (210 kms/3hrs) Reach Agra Check into hotel and rest, Later in the evening visit the symbol of eternal love-The Taj Mahal at sunset.

Taj Mahal:

The seventh wonder of the world is beautifully crafted with white marble was built under Mughal emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his love in 1630 to enshrine her mortal remains. Taj is known for the finest example of Mughal architecture with a style that combines elements from Turkish, Islamic and Persian. (Note: Taj Mahal Remain Closed on Friday)

Day 04 : Agra – Jaipur – Fatehpur Sikri

Morning continue the sightseeing of Agra – visit Agra Fort, Itmad ud daulah fort (Mini Taj)

Agra Fort:

Agra Fort is a Unesco World Heritage site built alongside the Yamuna river located in Agra. It stretches about 2.5 kms. Agra fort is one of the important fort in India. It is also known as Lal Qila, and Agra Fort.. Akbar chose this city on the bank of River Yamuna as his capital and proceeded to build a strong citadel for the purpose. Emperor Shah Jahan, who had built the Taj, was imprisoned by his son Aurangzeb in the Agra Fort where he had a view of the building erected for his deceased wife. It took 8 years and a huge amount of money to complete its construction. Agra Fort in Agra contains beautiful mosques - Nagina Masjid , Meena Masjid, Sheesh Mahal, Khas Mahal and .

Itmad ud daulah fort (Mini Taj)

Nicknamed the Baby Taj, the exquisite tomb of Mirza Ghiyas Beg should not be missed. This Persian nobleman was Mumtaz Mahal's grandfather and Emperor Jehangir's wazir (chief minister). His daughter Nur Jahan, who married Jahangir, built the tomb between 1622 and 1628 in a style similar to the tomb she built for Jehangir near Lahore in Pakistan.

Afternoon proceed to Jaipur. On the Way you will visit Fatehpur Sikri.

Fatehpur Sikri: Is a small city in northern India, just west of Agra, founded by a 16th-century Mughal emperor. Red sandstone buildings cluster at its center. Buland Darwaza gate is the entrance to Jama Masjid Mosque. Nearby is the marble Tomb of Salim Chishti. Diwan-E-Khas hall has a carved central pillar. Jodha Bais Palace is a mix of Hindu and Mughal styles, next to the 5-story Panch Mahal that overlooks the site.

Continue to Jaipur, check into hotel for rest and relaxation.



Day 05

Jaipur - Sightseeing

Morning proceed on a sightseeing of Jaipur city known as pink city. City Palace , Amber Fort, Jantar Mantar, Hawa Mahal, Birla Mandir, Jaigarh Fort , Nahargarh Fort etc are places of interest, All this can be seen subject to time permitting and traffic only.

Amber Fort -

Amber is the classic romantic Rajasthani fort palace. Its construction was started by Man Singh I in 1592, and completed by his descendent Jai Singh I. Its forbidding exterior belies an inner paradise where a beautiful fusion of Mughal and Hindu styles finds its ultimate expression.

Jantar Mantar -

This is the largest and the best preserved of the five observatories built by Jai Singh II in different parts of the country. This observatory consisting of outsized astronomical instruments is still in use.

Hawa Mahal -

The ornamental facade of this "Palace of Winds" is a prominent landmark in Jaipur. It is a five-storey structure of sandstone plastered pink encrusted with fine trelliswork and elaborate balconies. The palace has 953 niches and windows. Built in 1799 by Pratap Singh, the Mahal was a royal grandstand for the palace women.

City Palace It was the seat of the Maharaja of Jaipur, the head of the Kachwaha Rajput clan. The palace was built between 1729 and 1732, initially by Sawai Jai Singh II, the ruler of Amber. He planned and built the outer walls, and later additions were made by successive rulers continuing up to the 20th century.

Birla Mandir:

Birla Mandir is located towards the southern end of Hussain Sagar Lake in Hyderabad. It is situated atop the Kala Pahad which is a twin hillock of Naubat Pahad.

Jaigarh Fort:

Jaigarh Fort is situated on the promontory called the Cheel ka Teela of the Aravalli range; it overlooks the Amer Fort and the Maota Lake, near Amer in Jaipur, Rajasthan, India.

Nahargarh Fort:

Nahargarh Fort stands on the edge of the Aravalli Hills, overlooking the city of Jaipur in the Indian state of Rajasthan. Along with Amer Fort and Jaigarh Fort,

Day 06:

Jaipur free & easy.. shopping.. Return .. Departure

In the Morning restand relaxation at the hotel till your flight time back home.. or will check out from the hotel and Proceed for some shopping in Jaipur, till your flight time to Jaipur Airport.

As you choose, Optional add on a 2 nights / 3 days Golden Temple tour to AMRITSAR, Punjab & the Wagha Border. This can be done in the beginning of the tour or at the end of the tour..

Day 1

Amritsar

Choose a flight journey from Jaipur, If you opt to have the Amritsar tour in the beginning, you can have a flight upto Amritsar, then continue with Delhi. After breakfast checkout from the Hotel and proceed to Amritsar. Upon arrival check in to your Hotel.

Amritsar is a city in the northwestern Indian state of Punjab, 28 kilometers from the border with Pakistan. At the center of its walled old town, the gilded Golden Temple (Harmandir Sahib) is the holiest gurdwara (religious complex) of the Sikh religion. It's at the end of a causeway, surrounded by the sacred Amrit Sarovar tank (lake), where pilgrims bathe.

Visit the Ranjit Singh Museum, Partition Museum, Akal Takht, Sadda Pind The Perfect Tourist Destination in Amritsar, Shop for Phulkari cloth and Amritsari jutti. After Sightseeing, return to the Hotel for Night stay.

Breakfast, Dinner. Overnight hotel.

Day 02:

Amritsar Sightseeing

Today continue the sightseeing, visit the majestic Golden Temple (The Most Beautiful Divine Place), The Jallianwala Bagh - This historical area is known for the massacre committed by General Dyer, during the British Rule. In the evening, visit Wagah border - The guard changing ceremony every evening in the India - Pakistan border is the highlight of the area. After sightseeing, return to the Hotel for the night stay. Dinner. Overnight stay at Amritsar.

Day 03:

Amritsar Departure

Have a delicious breakfast and check out from the hotel. As per your flight timings, some time free and easy for shopping, later Proceed to Amritsar Airport for your return journey back home.
