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Day 1

Depart from Cochin CAPE TOWN – the Mother City (South Africa)

Assemble at the Cochin International Terminal 3 at 00.30 hrs for a short briefing with your tour leader. Departure Early morning 04-00 am by Emirates airways flight to Cape town - the Mother City. Arrival Dubai and connect Emirates flight. Arrival Cape town International Airport, in the evening. After emigration, collect luggage, custom clearance, together as a group transfer to hotel. Check in and rest for a while. Transfer to the city area for dinner, enroute enjoy a brief visit to the city and its beauty. Overnight hotel. (Breakfast, Lunch in flight). Dinner at the Restaurant .

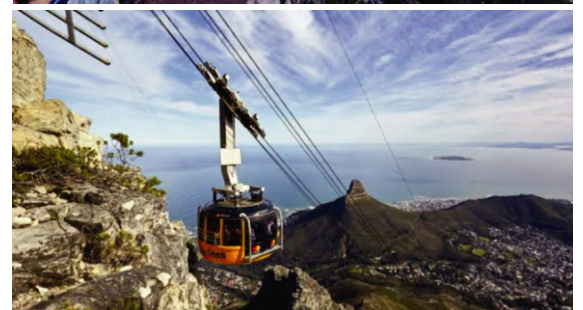


Day 2

CAPE TOWN Sightseeing – ROBBEN ISLAND - TABLE MOUNTAIN – V & A WATERFRONT

A full day tour of Cape town & Robben Island, where Dr. Nelson Mandela spent his jail life. Transfer to the V&A Waterfront. Enjoy a visit to Robben Island, is 3.5 hours long, including the two half-hour ferry rides. from the V & A Waterfront in Cape Town (weather permitting). During The Robben Island Tour enjoy a A return boat trip across Table Bay, A visit to the infamous Maximum Security Prison, & an Interaction with an ex-political prisoner, A 45-minute bus ride with a guide providing commentary, and an opportunity to explore the Murray's Bay Harbour precinct attractions, such as the Muslim shrine, or kramat, and the Museum Shop.

On return to Cape Town continue with a city tour of this Mother City. Drive through the scenic coastal area Clifton & Sea Point and the houses of Parliament, the Castle, District Six, Bo Kaap, Slave Lodge and the bustling Green Market Square. Continue to a cable car ride, which takes you up the Table Mountain (weather permitting, if not Signal Hill) for a breath taking view over the city. The Table Mountain is considered as one of the New 7 Wonders of nature. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Day 3

Peninsula Tour Cape Of Good Hope Nature Reserve.

A full day tour of the Peninsula, takes you to the best of the spectacular Cape Peninsular and why it is called the FAIREST CAPE. Drive past the Sea Point and Camps Bay, the famous beaches of Clifton and Llandudno towards the Hout Bay for Seal Islands. Continue your tour along the Atlantic Seaboard, through Noordhoek and Scarborough. Visit the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve. Enjoy the funicular ride aboard the Flying Dutchman and enjoy the spectacular views, take the photographs and videos of the second southern most tip of the African continent. Later visit the beautiful Boulders Beach and have the option to sit among the colony of Jackass Penguins. Return to hotel. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Day 4

Knysna

Wine Tasting – Garden Route – Knysna Lagoon Cruise

Your journey enroute the most beautiful Garden Route, enjoy a wine tasting(subject to availability) into Knysna. Explore the quaint town of Knysna known for its art & craft shops. "The place of the people, beauty and mystery." This ever-popular charming town of legend, history, arts and crafts catering to visitor's every need or fancy, is built on the banks of the Knysna Lagoon, a National Lake Area that falls under the protection of South African National Parks, is a home to more than 200 species of fish - including the rare Knysna seahorse - and is a popular destination for water sports enthusiasts and nature lovers alike. Enjoy a cruise on the vast Knysna Lagoon, a breath taking experience with surroundings. To the Knysna Heads a memorable activity. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Day 5

Knysna Oudtshoorn –

Cango Caves – Knysna Garden Routes

Depart on a full day tour Oudtshoorn tour is a town in the Western Cap Province in South Africa. With 80,336 inhabitants it is the largest town in the Little Karoo region. The town is home to the world's largest Ostrich population with a number of specialized ostrich breeding farms such as the Safari Show Farm. Arrive in Oudtshoorn and depart for a full day Oudtshoorn tour. Proceed to Cango Caves, internationally renowned as one of the world's great natural wonders, sculpted by nature through the ages. Their fascinating limestone formation occurs in a variety of ways. Visit the Cango Caves



Oudtshoorn is also the capital of the world for Ostrich. Nowhere else are ostriches found in such great number and nowhere else do they produce feathers of such fine quality - but the world's biggest bird is just one attraction in an area of enormous contrasts. Continue on to the Ostrich Ranch and come face to face with the biggest bird in the world. Finally, end your day at the Cango Wildlife Ranch. Over 300 crocodiles, ranging from 50 cm to four meters in length, inhabit the ranch. Return to your hotel for overnight stay. (Breakfast, Lunch at the Ostrich Farm, Dinner)



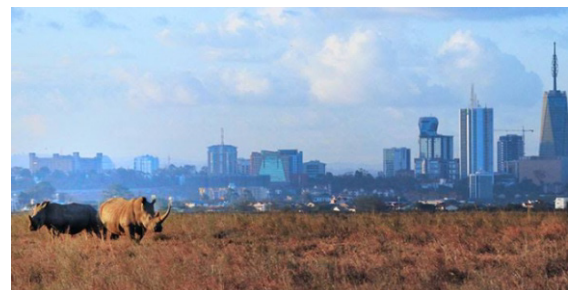
Day 6

Knysna - Cape Town

Fly To Nairobi , Kenya.

Today continue your journey to Kenya. Morning return to Capetown to take your onward flight to Nairobi or subject to flight availability proceed to George and fly to Nairobi. Upon arrival at Nairobi, Jomo Kenyatta Airport, transfer to hotel for rest and overnight stay. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Today those who want only South African tour will return to India & others will continue their journey into Kenya.



Day 7 **Nairobi – Lake Naivasha** **Masai Mara Game Reserve**

Morning proceed to Lake Naivasha for a leisurely boat ride in Lake Naivasha is a fresh water lake in Kenya section of Africa's Great Rift Valley, is located north west of Nairobi with the town of Naivasha on its north eastern shore. At 6,290 ft above sea level, the lake is at the highest point in the Kenyan Rift and is set in complex geological combination of volcanic rocks and sedimentary deposits from a much larger Pleistocene era lake.

Continue your tour via the Great Rift Valley to Masai Mara National Game Reserve – Jewel of Kenya's Game Park. Later enjoy an exhilarating game viewing drive, spotting lions, cheetahs and other predators. Overnight hotel. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Day 8 **Masai Mara** **Full Day Safari**

Morning continue with the game drive, in Masai Mara - This hilly region is both humid and fertile, and is crossed by the Mara and Talek rivers, full of crocodiles and hippos. The abundance of water and excellent availability of food are the reasons why the Masai Mara, which in fact is a continuation of the Tanzanian Serengeti National Park, has the greatest population of wild animals in the whole of Africa. There is a particularly dramatic "spectacle" from July to October, the annual migration of huge herds of Gnus and zebras. Predators such as Hyenas, Jackals, Leopards and Lions of course, closely follow these herds. Gigantic herds of over 200 buffaloes can also be observed. Plenty of food is available for elephants, giraffes, and the many species of antelopes. You can view the annual migration of

millions of wildebeests, Zebra, gazelles from the Serengeti plains across the Tanzania border and Mara river to reach Masai Mara grazing fields. The dramatic crossing of the river and the preying on the migrants by predators can be viewed from early June to August. It has also got thousands of species of bird life and plant life. Wild life viewing in the Mara region is a year round with plenty of species to be seen. Continue to visit more safari game driver including the famous Big 5. You may also get a chance to witness the kill in action, right in front of you. Later transfer to hotel. Rest and Relaxation. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Day 9 **Masai Mara** **Lake Nakuru**

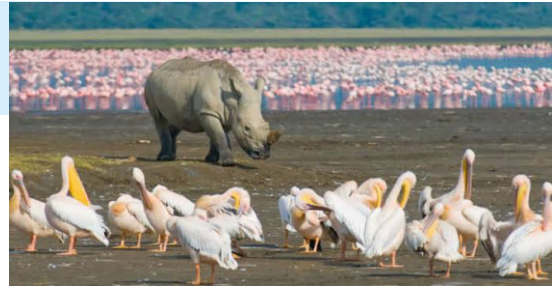
OPTIONAL (hot air balloon taking off in the beautiful early morning, you drift above the browsing game and have tremendous opportunities for unusual photographs. What could be more uplifting than an early morning safari in a hot air balloon flying over the vast plains of Africa? Witness an African sunrise as a plethora of wildlife roam the land beneath you. At the end of the flight you land on the plains, in the midst of this enchanting savannah a champagne breakfast is laid out with the mouth watering aroma of sausages, eggs, and bacon, sizzling over a charcoal fire. Drive in a leisurely fashion with game viewing on your way back to your camp).

Morning proceed for lake Nakuru, here enjoy the game drive in Lake Nakuru National Park, which has 56 different species of mammals including black and white Rhinoceros. This park has the rarest of the animal the white Rhinoceros. Lake Nakuru also has over 450 species of terrestrial birds including African fish eagle, kingfisher, Egrets, Marabou Stork and the most famous attraction is the Flamingos which round the lake in thousands. Transfer to hotel for rest and relaxation. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Day 10 Lake Nakuru – Nairobi Free & Easy ..shopping..

Return to Nairobi and spend a leisure day for shopping as well as spend your time for an excellent dinner in an African style including the varieties of meats. Overnight hotel. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Day 11 Nairobi – Elephant Orphanage & Giraffe Centre.. Return flight.

Today after a relaxed breakfast, check out of your hotel, proceed to ELEPHANT ORPHANAGE & GIRAFFE CENTRE. Spend the day visiting David Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage to observe baby and young orphaned elephants: viewing is strictly between 11am and 12pm. Then, you'll visit the Giraffe Center to experience a supervised feeding session.. in an open space, with a rope fence around it. The youngest elephants come trotting out of the bush to greet their keepers who stand at the ready with giant bottles of milk. For the next 10-15 minutes you can watch each little one slurp and gargle their milk. Then, you'll have time to watch the elephants play. You find out how old they were when they arrived at the orphanage, where they were rescued from, and what got them into trouble. The most common reasons for getting orphaned being: mother's poached, falling into wells, and human/wildlife conflict. Once the youngest are all fed, they are led back into the bush, and it's the turn of the 2-3 year olds. Some of them can feed themselves, and some are still fed by their keepers. Watch them interact with their keepers, munch on some branches of their favorite acacias, and play with the half drums of water and mud. You will then be driven to Giraffe centre where you feed Rothschild giraffes under the supervision of keepers. The center has rescued, hand-reared and released around 500 orphaned giraffes back into the wild since opening in 1979. This attraction offers opportunities to feed the endangered Rothschild's giraffe by hand. The location also offers a fine education on the physiology, behaviors and habitat preferences of these beautiful animals. Later after lunch, transfer to JKIA airport for your return flight to Cochin.. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner in flight.)



Day 12 Arrival Cochin

Say goodbye to your recently made friends and emigration, security, customs, on to India. Connect your flight from the Gulf hub into Cochin. Arrive in the morning hours (Breakfast, inflight)
